Whole School Notices

e-scooters - The Safer Essex Road Partnership

Some of our families will be celebrating Christmas and maybe considering buying e-scooters as gifts. The Safer Essex Road Partnership has provided the following important information to alert our parents and carers of the facts, legalities and dangers around e-scooters. Know your E-bikes

The key points:

- 1. Privately owned e-scooters are illegal to ride on the highway. Ones you can buy from shops like Halfords can <u>only</u> be used on privately owned land, with the landowner's permission.
- 2. Trial hire scooters can only be ridden by people 18 years plus, with a driver's licence. These scooters can only be used by the person who creates the Tier account.
- 3. Students storing e-scooters on school grounds can cause a fire risk with lithium battery fires.
- 4. Riding an e-scooter puts the rider at much higher risk on the roads, any collision may be more serious.
