Update on Student Arrangements due to RAAC Remedial Works

I am writing again to update you on the RAAC situation at CCHS.

The team of builders have continued to work daytimes, evenings and weekends to try and return the affected classrooms back to the school as quickly as possible.

So far we have had the art and drama rooms completed and returned to us. Assuming all goes well, we are hopeful that we can have the two remaining areas (upstairs in F & G Block) returned by Monday, 25th September. This will allow all year groups to be on site from this date. If there is any change to the deadline for completion of the work we will notify you at the earliest opportunity.

The plan for next week remains as follows:

WEEK COMMENCING 18th September	
Monday, 18th September	Years 7, 9, 10 and 11 in school. Year 8 live online lessons at home.
Tuesday, 19th September	Years 7, 8, 10 and 11 in school. Year 9 live online lessons at home.
Wednesday, 20th September	Years 7, 9, 10 and 11 in school. Year 8 live online lessons at home.
Thursday, 21st September <i>N.B. School finishes after Lesson 3 at 1.15pm, including online lessons, due to our Annual Open Evening.</i>	Years 7, 8,10 and 11 in school. Year 9 live online lessons at home.
Friday, 22nd September	Years 7, 9, 10 and 11 in school. Year 8 live online lessons at home.

The only remaining remedial works will then be to our Library space and the one classroom above this, however, the good news is that this work will not affect us being fully operational once F & G blocks are returned.

Moving forward, the school will be looking at longer term solutions to the remedial repairs, but where possible, this will be planned during school holiday periods to limit any impact on our student's education.
