- Black pen x2

All assessments and mock exams are an extremely important part of the preparation for GCSE subject exams as they will not only provide a crucial opportunity to prepare for the actual summer exams, but will help gauge progress and the individual student priorities for moving forward.

The mock exam grades are also part of the evidence used by teachers to make predicted grades for applications to further education. Should your child miss a mock exam they will score a '0' for that paper and therefore they are more likely to gain a lower grade overall. If this is in a subject where there is only one paper - this will result in a U grade for this subject.
