Re: Actual Practical Exams and Mock Exams Friday 14th February - Monday 3rd March

Just before the upcoming half term, we begin our second round of mocks for this examination series and next week students start taking some of their actual practical exams. Communication regarding these practical exams will have been sent individually from subject leads, please ensure your child attends all of these practical exams and prepares themselves appropriately as they are crucial to completing the subject courses.

The timetable for the mock exams can be found [here](#) and students were issued with a hard copy last week. These mock exams are an extremely important part of the preparation for the summer exams. They not only provide a vital opportunity for students to practice exam techniques and develop an understanding of the expectations and protocols for the formal exams but will help them gauge their personal progress and identify their individual priorities.

Revision

Many of our students are already taking personal responsibility for their preparations for the summer exams and have been opting-in to the Passport to Prom initiative, by attending after-school revision sessions and completing independent study. If your child has yet to commit to the opt-in opportunities available to help them prepare for their examinations, which begin only ten school weeks from now, it is not too late. Exam attendance and Punctuality

Attendance to all scheduled external/actual and mock exams is compulsory. It is important to note, that there are no opportunities to resit papers, therefore we value your support by ensuring that your child arrives for every scheduled exam and that they are on time and fully prepared.

For all exams, punctuality is key to reducing exam stress, for both your child and others. Part of this process is starting exams on time and limiting the impact of disruption and stress on all students within the exam room setting. We ask all our students and CCHS families to familiarise themselves with our [Late to Exams protocol](#). Please can you check carefully with your child that they understand the Late to Exam protocol and have all the equipment they need for each exam as detailed below:

- Black biro x 2
- Pencil, ruler and rubber
- Highlighter pen for subjects such as English, History, Geography, RE
- Scientific calculator for Maths, Science and Geography papers
