# **Whole School Notices**

# Are you eligible for Free School Meals?

If your child is eligible for free school meals, a daily allowance of £3 will be automatically added to their dinner account to use on a main meal each day. Your child will have access to these funds in the same way as they would if you had topped up their dinner account from your bank account. This process ensures that students receiving FSMs do not stand out in any way removing any concerns you may have about being treated differently in this regard.

FSM allowances will show only to the staff member on the till in our canteen (Clouds) You will not see the £3 credit on your child's Arbor account but once eligibility is approved the daily allowance will be automatic (it will not accumulate if unused)

As earnings may fluctuate from month to month, applicants in receipt of Universal Credit will have their earnings assessed over a period lasting up to three months – only complete assessment periods will be checked.

### Homework

Students in years 7, 8 & 9 are set homework in English, Maths and Science only. The aim here is to strive for 100% completion of homework. All homework for years 7-9 is set on Sparx.

The only exception to this is students may receive revision material prior to assessment weeks.

## How to access Sparx?

Sparx applications <u>Sparx Maths</u>, <u>Sparx Reader</u> and <u>Sparx Science</u> utilise the Google platform for access. Click on the links above and then click "Log in to Sparx using Goggle G" **Do not try to enter a username and password.**


